- That God would continue to give us vision for how we can use the building to reach the surrounding community for His Glory



God is definitely on the move and has blessed both our local and global outreach ministries! We are amazed as He continues to open new doors into the Knightsbridge community, and we are thrilled at what the Holy Spirit is doing in, around, and through our overseas midterm missionaries in Japan! Here is an update on what is going on.

### **SCOTT HOULE & TANIKAH ROBERTS IN JAPAN**



Both Scott and Tanikah have adjusted well in the roles they have in the churches they are serving at. It is a joy and encouragement to see how they are experiencing God in ways they have never before. According to their reports, they have been encouraged and challenged to see the Japanese Christians commit themselves to the ministry and mission there regardless of how hard the spiritual ground is and how seemingly little the fruit appears to be. They are happily busy in accomplishing the tasks given to them plus learning the language. They also are now past the “honeymoon” stage and are entering the “homesick” stage (which is expected) despite the amazing things they see God doing around them. God is definitely stretching them and pushing them out of their comfort zones! But it outside of comfort



that we can experience God’s presence the most! Please continue to pray that God would use them to work well with our partner churches (Tsukuba Grace Chapel and Yonezawa Christ Church) and they be instruments to share the Gospel in Japan. Pray that they will be sensitive and responsive to the way God is leading them as they seek His will for their futures.

### **D.I.Y SHORT-TERM MISSION – ANDRAYA LEWIS**

It is so exciting to see God stirring in the hearts of His people. Andraya joined our short-term mission trip to Japan last year and was moved by the Holy Spirit to return – by herself! Being a teacher, Andraya’s skill set fit right in with what our partner churches needed. We arranged for her to go and visit 4 different churches to hold English Day Camps for children. She was able to team up with Scott and Tanikah during her time there as well! These camps are a great way to connect the community with the local church! A total of 65 kids came out to the camps! Please continue to pray that the seeds planted in their hearts would bear fruit in due season.

## LOVE KNIGHTSBRIDGE

“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.”  
Ephesians 2:8-10

This verse is very familiar to most of us. The first part (v8-9) is a fundamental passage that supports salvation by grace and not works. But many times we forget or

ignore verse 10 which is intrinsic to our salvation. As believers and followers of Jesus, we already have our work “cut out” for us. God has prepared “work” for us to do; our mission.

As God continues to open doors of ministry opportunities in the Knightsbridge community, I cannot help but be amazed and convinced that God has led our church to this community. God has work for us to do at Knightsbridge and He is just starting to show us chapter 1 the book he has already written. Let’s lookback at what God did this past summer:

## CANADA DAY BLOCK PARTY

Our Children’s Ministry, Youth & Young Adult Ministry, Jeevan Deep Ministry (South Asian Outreach) and Missions joined forces to host our very first collaborative event! We hosted a party for the Knightsbridge community in celebration of Canada Day. Many of the families in the Knightsbridge apartments are newcomers to Canada and so it was a treat for them. But more importantly, it was rare and unique opportunity for us to connect and build relationships with the families there. We had bouncy castles, food, music, games, face and hand painting and much more! Despite it being held on a statutory holiday, we had around 70 volunteers come out to serve! At the end of the day, there were around 700 – 800 people who came to the event. It was a huge success!



## KINS CAMP & ACROSS QUEEN

Our KINs (Kids in the neighbourhood) team ran a 4 day VBS camp in mid-July and it was well attended with a total of 91 kids throughout the week! 21 Volunteers helped make this camp a great time of relationship-building with families we met during the Canada Day party. We then followed this VBS with the Across Queen Camp Outreach in which Pastor Mark and our youth and young adults conducted another camp for the same kids. Despite being rained out for 2 days, the kids were so eager to join the camp! God provided us opportunities to serve the children and their families through these three events but He also used it to exponentially increase the trust level between us and the community! Praise God for this development.



## BACK-TO-SCHOOL BACK PACK DISTRIBUTION

Finally, God unexpectedly opened the door for us again! As the Peel Family Shelter had more than enough backpacks this year, we were able to direct your school supply donations to the children at Knightsbridge. This was definitely another foundational building block in our trust relationship with the community. Total of 155 backpacks were distributed.



Please pray for the new initiatives we are starting this fall. Greater things are in store for the Knightsbridge Community!

## A WORD FROM BBC KIDS

2019 Summer ministries has been fantastic! Coming off of the school year into a busy summer of camp ministry, I was joined by our wonderful summer ministry Interns and volunteers to impact many different children with God's love. Thank you to those who helped to support us through your time, talents and financial help. We exceeded our \$35,000 goal and your generosity in serving God in these areas released us to minister to so many different people from all walks of life and to encourage them on their spiritual journey as they build their relationship with God and others.



This summer over 700 spots have been created for our camps and we have been able to minister to over 250 children and their families on a weekly basis through our various camps & Sunday ministries. Over 200 children have chosen to follow Jesus. We were joined by Pastor Mark & Pastor Steve for DIVE IN: Camp Rokhawah 2019 and were able to see 143 kids and leaders attend. They were able to build friendships, focus on their relationship with Jesus and learn about diving in to God's word to see His plan and purpose for our lives. God is good! As we gear up this fall for another year of ministry, I look forward to seeing God move in and through those of you who are serving in so many areas and I look forward to seeing each person (young or young at heart) who come through our ministries embraced with God's love.
